



# IADC SAFETY AWARD SUBMISSIONS OPEN

The International Association of Dredging Companies (IADC) is a global umbrella organisation for contractors in the private dredging industry. It has over 100 main and associated members and encourages its members to establish common standards and a high level of conduct in their worldwide operations.

Safety is a core value and top priority within the dredging industry, and it maintains a level of safety that can compete with the offshore oil and gas sector. IADC is committed to promoting safety in the industry and established the Safety Committee that enables sharing of best practices among its members. The organisation aims to reduce the number of accidents and incidents in the industry.

The IADC Safety Award is intended to encourage the development of safety skills on the job and to reward people and companies demonstrating diligence in safety awareness in the performance of their profession.

Since 2021, the Safety Award is granted to one dredging contractor (also non-IADC members) and one supply chain organisation. This concerns subcontractors and suppliers of goods and services. As IADC, we realise that suppliers also play an important role in increasing safety in dredging by offering innovative solutions with the help of the latest technical developments.

## WHY A SAFETY AWARD?

1. To stimulate ideas in the workplace.
2. To encourage the development of safety skills on the job and safety awareness.
3. To make work safer.
4. Reward people and companies who make it possible to work safer.
5. Reward those who demonstrate special diligence in safety awareness in performing their profession.

## GUIDELINES FOR THE IADC SAFETY AWARD

The award will recognise the exceptional safety performance of a particular project, product, ship, team or employees.

The award is open to all dredging contractors, subcontractors and suppliers of goods and services active in the dredging industry. There is no limitation to the number of submissions that can be submitted by any one company. This PDF serves as a template for your submission. Please see below for more information on the registration procedure. A separate registration form must be completed for each submission. Submissions must be supported by this document that describes the details of the accomplishments. The identified work should be recognised and supported with evidence by means of safety record(s), objectives reached and other relevant information.

## WHO PRESENTS THE SAFETY AWARD?

The IADC Board of Directors will present the awards at the IADC Annual General Meeting in September 2024 in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam.

# IADC SAFETY AWARD SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The IADC Board of Directors will choose the recipient based on an evaluation in accordance with the following guidelines:

- The award is open to all dredging contractors, subcontractors and suppliers of goods and services active in the dredging industry. There is no limitation to the number of submissions that can be resubmitted by any one company. A separate registration form must be completed for each submission;
- Each submission must be accompanied by this document that describes the details of the accomplishments;
- The identified work should be recognised and supported with the evidence by means of safety record(s), objectives reached and other relevant information;
- The submission has to be dredging related;
- The submission must contribute to safety in the dredging industry;
- The submission has to be innovative, original and communicable;
- The submission must be suitable for a "best practice" publication;
- The submission can be technical, procedural or of any other type;
- The submission will be assessed on:
  - sustainability;
  - level of impact on the industry;
  - simplicity of use;
  - effectivity; and
  - level of innovation;
- The submission is either a proven technology or has development potential;
- In the case of proven technology, it is not commonly known;
- The Safety Committee will rank the submission based on the degree of compliance with the guidelines;
- The Safety Committee will propose the top three submissions to the IADC Board;
- The IADC Board will select the winner;
- The award consists of:
  - a small sculpture;
  - PR attention shared in the *Terra et Aqua* journal, on IADC's website and in a press release;
  - a "best practice" publication;
- Travel costs to the Annual General Meeting will be compensated for an external party.
